**Union Lake Sailing and Tennis Club is a small (150 memberships) organization.** The club operates by membership participation, guided and monitored by an elected (from the general membership) nine-person Board of Directors (BOD). The ULSTC offers year-round club activities and events for both adults and kids and is famous for the beautiful serenity of the lake's sunset vistas. Events, races, tennis matches, or parties are accomplished by your direct personal and family members' participation. The general membership also handles the routine cleanup (taking out the trash and recycling) and minor maintenance. We do not have any routine hired help, (and only do so for heavy lift jobs or serious maintenance issues, such as tree removal, etc.). Helping the BOD out are volunteer committees that oversee club events, parties, and special projects. These committees take advantage of our individual club members' expertise and enthusiasm to accomplish desired tasks.

Membership runs concurrently with the calendar year and is payable each January regardless of when the member joined
